Noxolo Eileen Mazibuko grew up in New Brighton Port Elizabeth in the Eastern Cape where she also completed secondary education in a local secondary school. After school she went on to obtain a Primary Teachers certificate in 1974 (Butterworth Training college) and Auxiliary nursing diploma in 1977 at Livingstone hospital (PE) where she worked for almost ten years as a nurse. After nursing she studied full-time at Vista University -Port Elizabeth campus where she completed the degrees BA, and BCOM (Hon), MCOM and PhD. She is a full professor in the Business Management Department at Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University (NMMU). Prof Mazibuko joined Vista University (PE campus) in 1991 and was promoted through the ranks to Senior Lecturer in Business Management. In 2004 she became an Associate Professor at the University of Port Elizabeth and in January 2008 she obtained a promotion and became a Full Professor at NMMU in the Department of Business Management. She is currently a head of the Department of Business Management at NMMU. During her years in the academic field, she has acted as Head of the Department on several occasions and a programme leader for many academic modules. She also assisted with the merger of the three institutions by representing the Vista campus on the Strategic Planning Joint Task team for the new institution namely, the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University (NMMU). She also served on the Executive Faculty Committee and currently she is a member of the Faculty M&Ds Committee and Faculty Research Committee and senate of the NMMU.

Prof Mazibuko is much-admired for her community-based research including issues regarding affordable housing finance, HIV/AIDS, Waste management and women entrepreneurial skills and shopping habits of the inhabitants of NMBM. Also, she has completed research projects on employees and unions organizational commitment and their perceptions on Share-ownership schemes.
